



Landowner Incentive Program Program Information

- Any landowner within the King Conservation District boundary may apply.
- The applicant will be required to have either an approved farm plan, forest stewardship plan, or be currently receiving technical assistance from the King Conservation District in order to apply.
- An applicant may only apply for one best management practice at a time.
- There will be no reimbursement for purchases made before the acceptance letter is received.
- In-kind labor and machinery is eligible for reimbursement.

The King Conservation District's Landowner Incentive Program promotes good stewardship by helping landowners pay for conservation projects on their land. The program covers 50 to 90% of the project cost with the remainder to be provided by the applicant. The list of funded projects includes both agricultural

and non-agricultural best management practices. There is no lifetime maximum on the number of projects a landowner can fund through the program. However, the landowner must complete and receive reimbursement for a funded practice before a new application will be considered.

| Subsurface Drain (French Drain) | 50% | \$20/ft |
| Upland Wildlife Habitat Management | 75% | \$20,000/project |
| Waste Storage Facility | 75% | \$1,000/animal unit |
